APPLIED

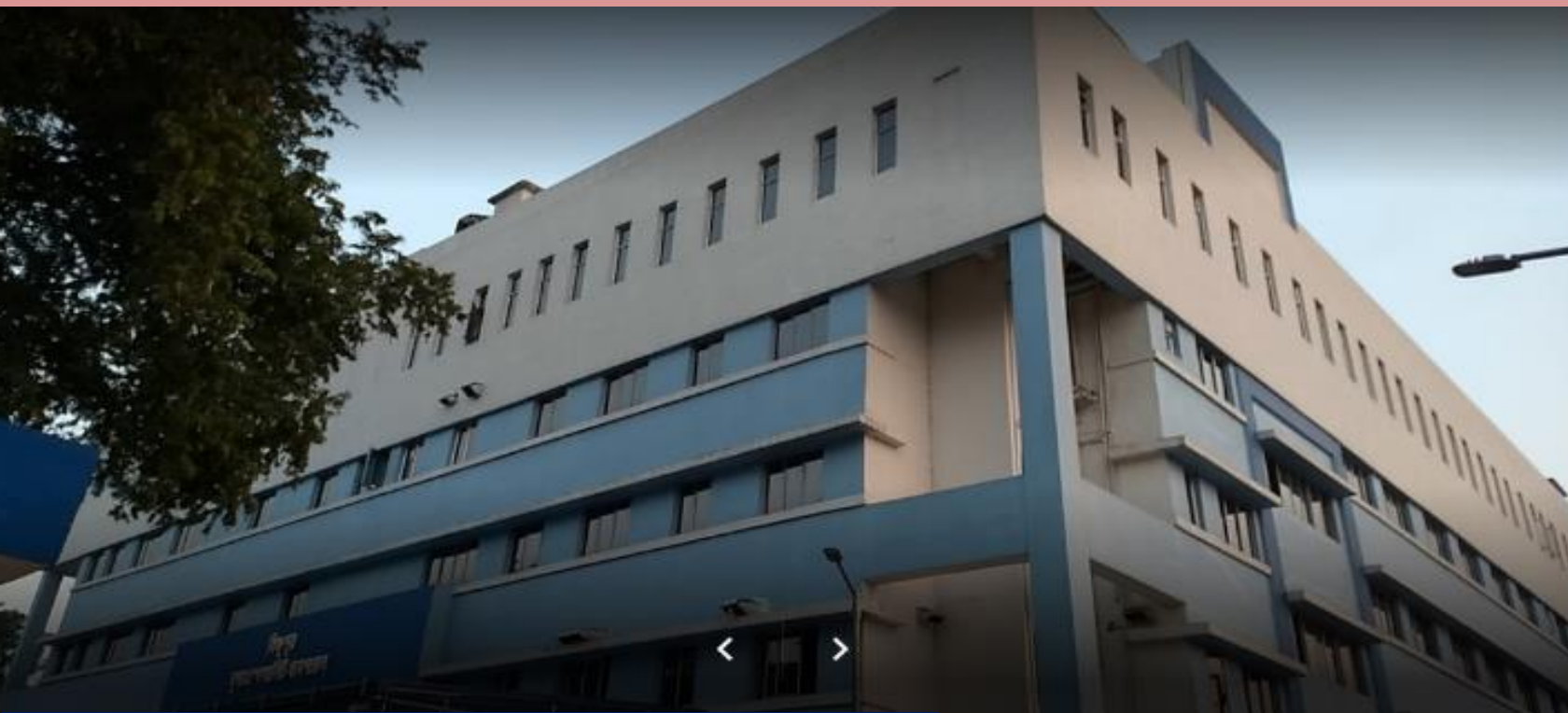

The basis of NEET Score and through Online Central Counselling Process conducted by (MCC) Director General of Health Services (DGHS), New Delhi. All the relevant information regarding MBBS Admissions will be displayed on the following website <https://mcc.nic.in/>

Admission Procedure:

MBBS Admissions will be done on the basis of NEET Score and through Online Central Counselling Process conducted by (MCC) Director General of Health Services (DGHS), New Delhi.

All the relevant information regarding MBBS Admissions will be displayed on Central Government website <https://mcc.nic.in/>. It is advised that all closely follow the notifications as & when put up by the MCC, New Delhi regarding Counselling Schedule, Registration, Choice Filling etc. (To secure admission at MGM Medical College, Aurangabad for MBBS Course Candidates needs to opt MGM Medical College, Aurangabad as the preferred choice while filling the online preference on the <https://mcc.nic.in/>) NO ADMISSION IS ALLOWED/CAN BE DONE AT COLLEGE LEVEL.

Course Duration - (4 ½ Years + 1 Year Compulsory Internship)

Medium - The medium of instructions is English.

Number of Seats - 150

Category of Seats - WB State Quota - 50, Management Quota - 77 & NRI Quota -23

Eligibility Criteria:

The NEET score of NEET (UG)-2020 exam will be considered as eligibility criteria for MBBS admission. For further details candidates are requested to go through NEET (UG)-2020 Brochure available on <https://ntaneet.nic.in/>

- Candidates must have passed Class XII/higher secondary/pre-university qualifying examination with Science subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry and Zoology/Botany. They also must have studied English as the main subject for their qualifying examination.
- Moreover, candidates also need to fulfil the age limit criteria i.e. they must have completed 17 years of age at the time of admissions.
- There are additional eligibility conditions as mentioned by the regulatory authorities for MBBS i.e. Medical Council of India (MCI).

- Age proof
- Domicile Certificate
- Class XII mark sheet and pass certificate
- Valid ID proof (Voter ID card/Passport/Aadhar card/ School or College ID card)
- Caste Certificate (if applicable)
- Medical Certificate
- Physically Handicapped Certificate (if applicable)
- Counselling fees payment slip

Documents required for counselling:

- NEET UG admit card
- NEET UG scorecard
- Class 12 marksheet and pass certificate
- Class 10 pass certificate
- Provisional seat allotment letter provided during West Bengal MBBS and BDS counselling 2020
- Valid ID proof (Voter ID card/Passport/Aadhar card/ School or College ID card)
- Medical Certificate issued by a Registered Allopathic Doctor in practice
- Pre-counselling phase verification slip
- Final Verification Slip generated once the documents of the candidate have been verified
- SC/ST/OBC A/OBC B certificate, if applicable, issued by the competent West Bengal state authority
- Orthopedic Physical Disability Certificate, if applicable, must be issued by IPGMER-Kolkata medical board. No other PH certificate will suffice during document verification

NRI candidates:

- The following students are considered for the NRI quota
- The aspirant must be an Indian Origin settled in foreign countries.
- Students born in foreign countries but their parents are of Indian Origin.
- Children of Indian citizens staying abroad for employment, business
- Children of Indian citizens deputed overseas by Public Sector Undertaking.
- Children of the employees of the Central/State Government on deputation period staying abroad.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Candidates must possess a valid Indian passport.
- Eligible for admission only based on their NEET score.
- NRI Quota seats will be given only for bonafide NRI's.
- The NRI sponsored candidates must be a real blood relation to the NRI financial supporter like father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunty.

Additional Documents List for NRI Category Candidates:

- Notarized affidavit of the person who is NRI and the Sponsorer.
- Document claiming that the Sponsorer is an NRI (Valid passport, Visa & Indian Embassy.
- letter situated in that country.
- Relationship of NRI with the candidate (Notarised affidavit of family tree).
- Affidavit from Sponsorer that he/she will sponsor the entire course fee of the candidate.
- Embassy Certificate of the Sponsorer.

Selection Procedure:

Only those candidates who have successfully completed the document verification round will feature in the West Bengal MBBS and BDS merit list 2020. The candidates who are mentioned in the merit list will also be given their state ranks on the basis of NEET 2020 along with their name, NEET rank, NEET score and category basis which they have applied. Candidates who feature in the West Bengal MBBS merit list will be eligible for the state medical seat allotment round.

Fees Structure:

For MBBS seats to be filled up by the State Quota through the rules of reservation as applicable (NEET UG Qualified) the total course fees is Rs. 21,27,000/- (Tuition Fee 2,28,000 x 9 + Admission Fee 50000 + Caution Deposit 15000), Amount to be paid during admission Rs. 2,93,000 (Rs. 2,43,000 will be refunded on upgradation) Bank Guarantee for Discontinuation (to be submitted during the time of admission) - Rs. 18,24,000

Management Quota Fees is Rs. 83,23,000/- (Tuition Fee 9,27,000 x 9 + Admission Fee 1,00,000 + Caution Deposit 15000), Amount to be paid during admission Rs. 10,27,000 (Rs. 9,27,000 will be refunded on upgradation) Bank Guarantee for Discontinuation (to be submitted during the time of admission) - Rs. 72,96,000

Total Fee for NRI Quota is - USD 1,70,000

Hostel Facilities:

Hostel accommodation to all the students is compulsory so as to maintain regularity, sincerity, punctuality and discipline for quality medical education.

The hostel provides a cot, a study table, a chair and one almirah for each student. Each hostel has hot water facility, common TV room, common reading room, dining arrangements and indoor games facilities.

There is adequate dining space for all students to dine together at one time. Membership to the mess run in the hostel is compulsory.

Hostel Fees: Rs.25000/- (Registration-15000 + Caution Deposit - 10000)

Mess Charges:

Before commencement of the academic session, the Mess charges shall be collected annually on sharing basis.

Electricity Charges: Extra

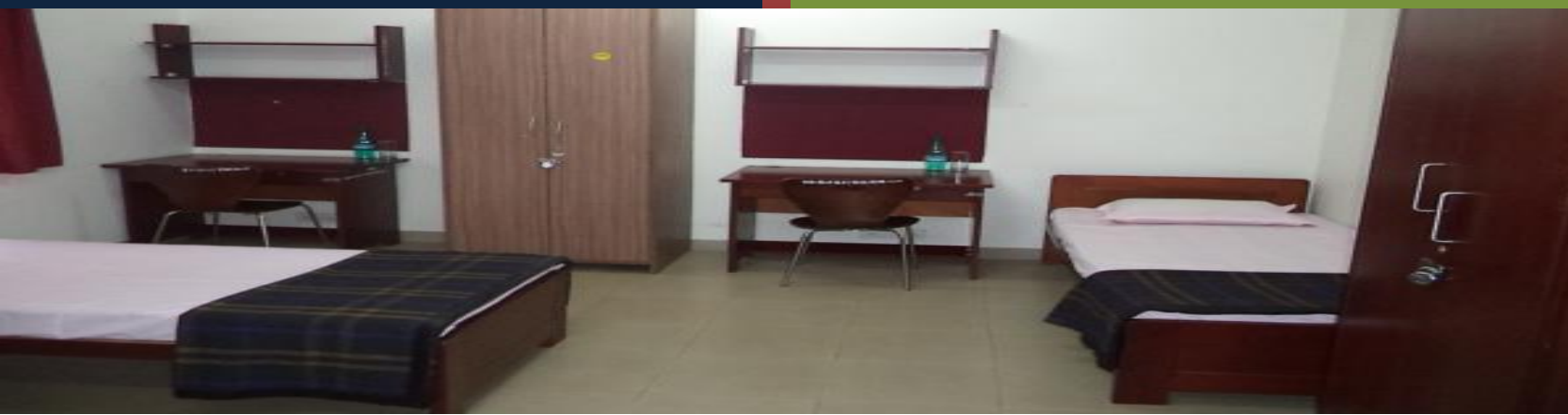
University Enrolment:

All the selected candidates admitted to the first MBBS course at MGMCH, under any category, are required to apply to the West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata on a prescribed proforma with the required fee for registration as per rules and regulations of the WBUHS, Kolkata. The admitted students must apply for enrolment as per the notification of the WBUHS.

Migration:

No application for migration to other Medical Colleges will be entertained from the students admitted to the MBBS course at this Institute. The President may grant NOC for migration of a student in the exceptional circumstances subject to prevailing rules & regulations of the MCI. However, the final approval will be granted by Medical Council of India.

RULES & REGULATIONS

RULES FOR STUDENTS

- Students can only enter the campus by showing their identity cards.
- Leaving campus before the scheduled timings will only be allowed with prior approval of the Principal.
- Ragging is strictly banned.
- Consumption of alcohol, tobacco or any narcotic substance is prohibited. NO shop or establishment is allowed to sell these items within 5 km of the campus and purchase of such items is punishable by law.
- Carrying of lethal weapons and explosive materials in the campus premises is strictly prohibited. Keeping such items in the hostel rooms is not allowed.
- Students cheating or using unfair means in university examination or class tests will be penalized. In addition, they will have to pay any penalty which the university authorities decide to impose.
- Bishnupur Public Institute of Medical Science and Bishnupur Super Specialty Hospital & Bishnupur District Hospital (PPP), Siromonipur, Bishnupur, Bankura, W.B campus is an eco-friendly place and is a plastic free zone. Students must comply with the garbage disposal system of the campus.
- Any kind of indiscipline, including ragging in the hostel and campus premises, will be punishable.
- All students must follow the dress code as prescribed.
- All the above conditions will be enforced strictly and those students who do not follow the above rules will be punished, even expelled.
- Save Water: All students are requested to use water judiciously and preserve it. Leakage in the bathrooms should be immediately reported to administration.



RULES FOR HOSTEL

- Students are not allowed to change rooms except with the written permission of the warden/ chief warden.
- Students will be asked to vacate the hostel if they fail to clear their dues of the hostel by the appointed day.
- Conserve Electricity: Residents should switch off the lights, fan, ACs, etc., when not in use. Use of heaters, electric rods etc., in the hostel is not allowed.
- Students are allotted rooms in the hostels for a period of one year and will pay for the entire period. No refunds are permitted. Students may be required to shift to other blocks/rooms as and when informed by hostel authorities. This shifting maybe necessitated due to administrative reasons.
- Proxy or dummy roommates are forbidden. Residents are not permitted to allow their rooms to be used by others. Visitors are not allowed to stay overnight.
- If a resident wishes to vacate the hostel, prior information must be given to the warden. Permission of the student's parents and principal along with certain documentation is necessary. All hostel dues must be paid by the resident at the time of vacating the hostel.
- Pets are not allowed inside the hostel. Feeding stray animals is not permitted.
- Cooking is not allowed in the hostel rooms.
- Playing of loud music, partying and shouting is not permitted.
- All maintenance complaints/requirements will be attended to by attendant on duty. Complaint(s) must be entered in the register(s) available with security guard at the hostels. The complaints will be attended and monitored by the wardens/ chief warden. Residents are not permitted to employ any outsiders for any such job without the permission of chief warden.
- The rooms have been painted as per schedule and will be maintained regularly by the management as per the maintenance schedule. Residents are not permitted to re-paint or do any alteration of any nature without the written permission of the warden.
- The students shall be responsible for the college & hostel property issued or provided to them in the hostel. Damage of any hostel property shall be recovered from the concerned student.
- Principal or the chief warden /wardens or any person in authority can inspect any room at any time.
- Entry in the hostels will not be allowed beyond 9.00 pm.
- Attendance of hostel residents will be taken daily within 15 minutes of the hostel closing time.
- Absence from hostel without prior permission from the hostel warden is an act of serious misconduct.
- No meeting or gathering is permitted in the hostels/ dining room.
- Students must dine in their respective hostel messes. Carrying food items from dining hall to hostel rooms is strictly prohibited.
- Removal of hostel property (that is, bed, chairs, etc.) from the room is not allowed.
- Students are required to come in the hostel mess and common room in proper clothing.
- All complaints and suggestions shall be made to the respective hostel committee.
- Students are not permitted to spend weekend/ holidays with their relatives outside the campus, unless specific permission is taken. In the request, parents / guardians will give an authorization with the name and address of the local guardian.
- Parents / guardians/ guests / friends of students can visit only during the stipulated timings.
- In case of any electricity failure, residents must bring to the notice of the caretaker/warden. The service of an electrician is available round the clock for attending to any defect in the electric system or settings.
- The rooms and surroundings must be kept clean. The service of the cleaners must be obtained to ensure that the rooms are swept and toilets cleaned while the residents are in the room. All wastepaper and refuse must be placed in garbage bags provided for that purpose.
- Fire Hazards and Safety: Candles and incense are a fire hazard and are not permitted in the hostels. Combustible materials such as gasoline, paint thinner and oil lamps are not permitted in the hostels. Burning/bursting of crackers, carrying of crackers to the rooms and lighting of lamps / candles are banned strictly in and around the hostel premise.
- If a resident falls sick, he / she or roommate / friend must immediately inform the caretakers /warden, who will take necessary action.

WHAT CONSTITUTES RAGGING

Vide clause 3 of UGC regulations on curbing the menace of ragging dated 17th June, 2009
Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts.

- Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing of generating a sense of shame, or torment of embarrassment so as to adversely effect of physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- Any act by the senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or group students.
- Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student.
- Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.
- Any act of abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic from activity or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student.
- With or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher of any other student.

Action to be taken by the Head of the Institution

(vide clause 7 of UGC regulations on curbing the menace of ragging dated 17th June 2009).

On receipt of recommendation of the Anti-Ragging Squad or on receipt of any information concerning any reported incident of ragging, the Head of Institution shall immediately determine if a case under the penal laws is made out and if so, either on his own or through a member of the Anti-Ragging Committee authorized by him in this behalf, proceed to file a First Information Report (FIR), within twenty four hours of receipt of such information or recommendation, with the police and local authorities, under the appropriate penal provisions relating to one or more of the following,

- Abetment to ragging
- Criminal conspiracy to rag
- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging
- Public nuisance created during ragging
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging
- Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt
- Wrongful restraint
- Wrongful commitment.
- Use of criminal force
- Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences
- Extortion
- Criminal trespass
- Offences against property
- Criminal intimidation
- Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s)
- Threat to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s)
- Physical or psychological humiliation
- All other offences following from the definition of "Ragging"

N **RAGGING**

RAGGING **IS A CRIME**

POSSIBLE PUNISHMENTS

Those found guilty of ragging may be awarded one or more of the following punishments, namely: (vide clause 9 of UGC regulations on curbing the menace of ragging dated 17th June, 2009)

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- Withholding results.
- Debarring from representing the Institution in any regional, national or International meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- Cancellation of admission.
- Rustication from the Institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- Expulsion from the Institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.
- Fine of Rs. 25000/-

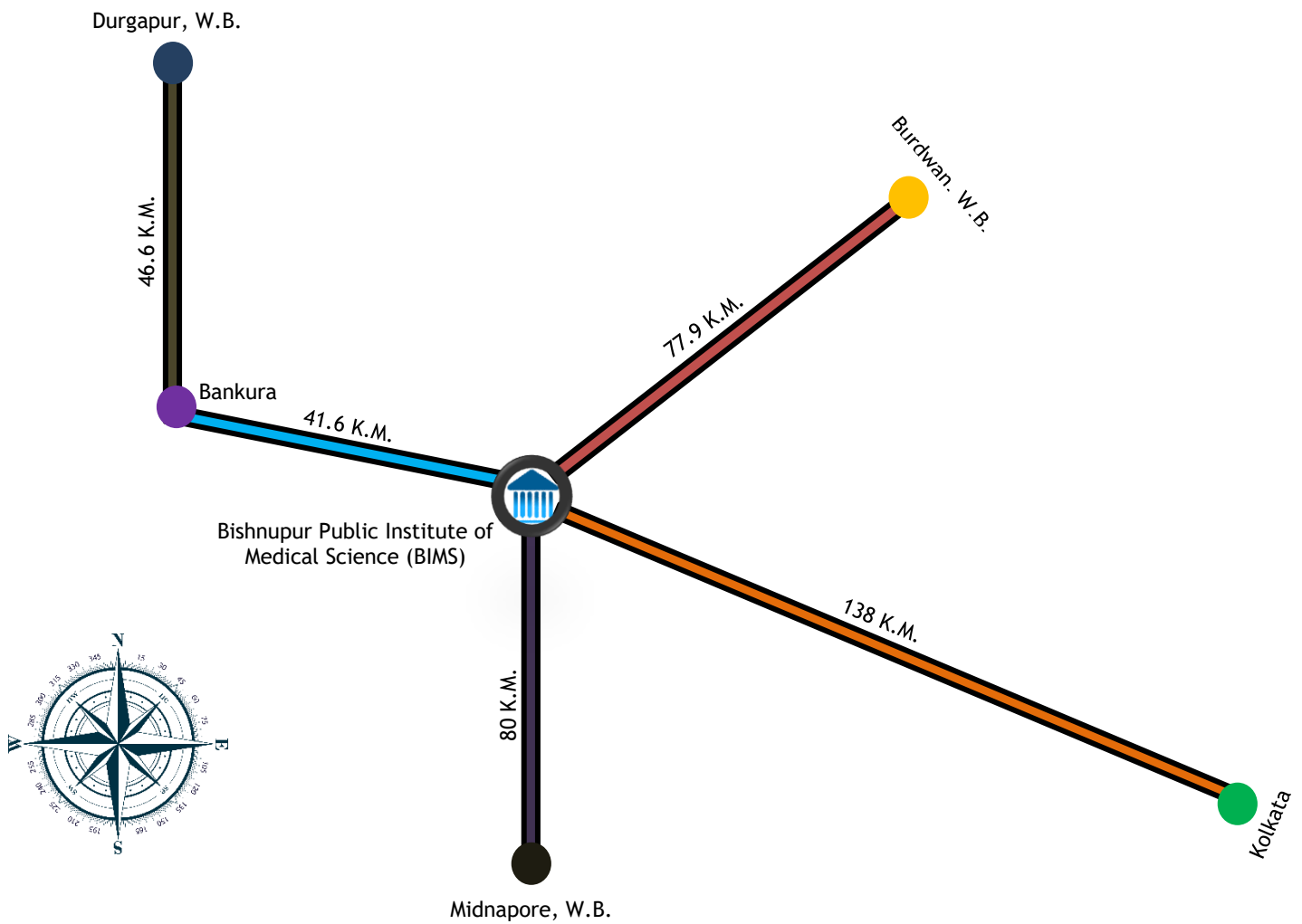
